

The architecture of light


Deconstructivist approach. Collage-like architectural volumes. Expressive design language. What defines the buildings by Frank O. Gehry also shapes cloud. The light sculpture is the first luminaire to be developed for series production by the architect and Pritzker Prize laureate – in collaboration with belux.

Inspiration: paper

Gehry regards cloud as an homage to Isamu Noguchi, with whom he shares a commitment to sculptural quality and refined construction. And above all: a fascination with paper. His first prototype consisted of intricately shaped shells of packing paper, fastened together with staples.

cloud forever

For reasons of safety, a specially treated polyester fleece was chosen as the design material. It evokes the appearance and touch of paper, but it is tear resistant, durable, easy to clean and fire retardant. Equipping cloud with everything required to make it a companion of many years.



Unique pieces in series

No two clouds are the same. The folds are created at random during production and can be reshaped by hand at any time. A rise here, a dip there – do it yourself. In true Gehry fashion, as his creations probe the limits of structural balance and make movement their guiding design principle. Experience design in a new way: floating on a cloud.

Aesthetic. Poetic. Iconic

Frank O. Gehry describes his light sculpture cloud as being intended to convey a sense of freedom and eccentricity. For 20 years, the iconic cloud has been fulfilling precisely this wish – now, for its anniversary, also in colour.

XL in size. XXL in colour.

Voluminous, yet seemingly weightless: cloud XL RGBW shines in countless colours – enhancing the atmosphere and expanding design possibilities. Subtle or intense? Harmonious or energising? Colour your cloud.




